PASTOR'S CORNER

One of the great gifts to our parish community is Our Lady's Chapel, a beautiful, holy space for quiet prayer and meditation. A related blessing to our parish is the regular opportunity for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, each Friday following the 8:15 a.m. Mass, in the Chapel. Spending some quality time in the presence of the Risen Lord, as did the early disciples hiding out in the catacombs of Rome, is a rich source of grace and spiritual strength. I know that, in my own life, the more space I open in my heart to Christ's Presence to me during Adoration, the more deeply I appreciate the great gift of his Life to me when I receive the Holy Eucharist at Mass.

I would encourage all parishioners, young and old, to stop by Our Lady's Chapel on Fridays for quiet time and prayer, if only for a few moments.

After much thought and discussion among the deacons and priest of the parish, in the interests of pastoral planning, *we will be changing the regular time of Benediction from 7:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.* We make this change for two reasons. One, we hope that 5 p.m. might be a more convenient time for parishioners to come to this brief prayer service and blessing known as Benediction, particularly in the dark winter months. Also, given the pastoral and family responsibilities of our priests and deacons at 7:30 p.m. on any given night, the 5 p.m. time is more realistic and manageable.

Please note this change to our schedule and, again, try to make time on Fridays to make a spiritual visit to our Lord. You will be blessed!

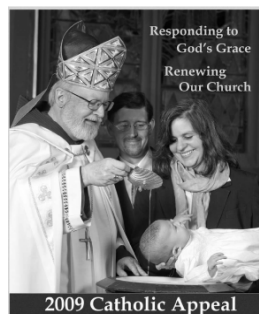
2009 Baccalaureate

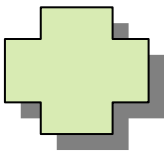

A few music "Notes." You will notice there is a new hymnal in the pews. Breaking Bread is a comprehensive publication complete with all Sunday readings. It also contains all the daily Mass propers (yellow pages at the back). Breaking Bread is an annual subscription based on the calendar, so it will be replaced each January. In addition, there is a full music issue which is much more inclusive than in "Today's Missal." This expands our resources to provide songs such as "Rise Up With Him," "Ubi Caritas," "Christ Be Our Light," "Worthy Is The Lamb," to name just a few for all of you who would like to sing more of the music you have been hearing from the choirs. And it will eliminate most use of worship aids that provide much clutter and a good amount of confusion. With this wonderful resource, new music will appear each year, so that along with the pearls of many traditional hymns and favorites in our Gather hymnals, we will all have access to a large selection from the wealth of excellent music that is being published now. To assist in reading the hymn charts located on either side of the altar, the numbers designated for any reference to Breaking Bread will have a "B " in front of them. The Mass for each Sunday will now be found in Breaking Bread (and often will include the same psalm tune which the cantor will sing).
