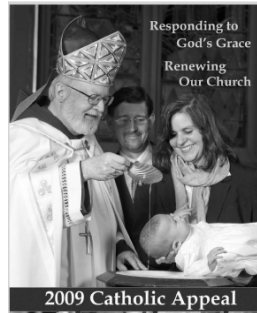

For a person earning \$52,000 yearly, that would mean \$25 weekly; for a person earning \$104,000, that would mean \$50 weekly.
