This channel features the popular and engaging speaker, Fr. Mike Schmitz. Another helpful resource is a book entitled *How to Defend the Faith (without Raising Your Voice)* by Austen Ivereigh, which provides civil responses to Catholic hot-button issues by reframing the argument so hearts can be opened and minds can be inspired.

Growing in knowledge and understanding of our Catholic faith is a life-long endeavor. ## THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION REINSTATED -

Aware that the opportunity to participate in Sunday Mass is now widely available and increasingly safe for our Catholic people, Cardinal Sean has lifted the dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day Mass obligation, which was granted during the pandemic. This does not apply to those who are ill, those who have been recently exposed to COVID or any other communicable illness, those who are confined to their homes or other facilities due to illness, infirmity or age, and those who are not yet able to be vaccinated due to age or health consideration. Our parish will continue to live-stream our 9:00 am Sunday Mass for people in these circumstances. To all of those who have not been with us during this past year, we look forward to welcoming you back to the celebration of Mass here at Holy Family!

**HEALTH CARE PROXY** - Very few of us think about serious illness when we are healthy. We should think ahead about what would happen if we became incapable of making our own health decisions. Stroke, dementia, unconsciousness or incompetency are just a few ways we can lose the capacity to make decisions about our treatment. Under Massachusetts law, any adult resident may authorize a person as an agent to make medical decisions in the event the ability to make these decisions is lost. A person fills out a Health Care Proxy form to name an agent. The agent can be a spouse, relative, or friend who knows the person and is trusted by him or her. The agent is empowered to make all health care decisions. Having someone legally empowered to make these decisions lessens the likelihood of family discord regarding a loved one's treatment. The Massachusetts Catholic Conference has a Health Care Proxy form consistent with Church teaching which you can download from <http://macatholic.org/proxy>. Visit the website, review the form and prayerfully consider appointing a health care agent for yourself.

**PREGNANT?** - There is help. *Pregnancy Help* serves anyone facing crisis pregnancy situations. With offices in Brighton, Natick and Brockton, the nurses and case workers are trained to give individualized free and confidential care to help you through this difficult time. Pregnancy Testing / Limited Obstetrical Ultrasound / Options Counseling / Supportive Services and Referrals / Ongoing Support. During the pandemic, staff members are available by phone, text and email; no walk-in appointments available. Visit [www.pregnancyhelpboston.org](http://www.pregnancyhelpboston.org) for more information.

### UPDATED MASS ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES -

Masks are no longer required for vaccinated people in the State of Massachusetts. The State does advise that non-vaccinated people continue to wear masks. We no longer require masks in church. If you would like to continue to wear a mask, you are always welcome to do so. We have a section specially designated for those who wish to sit socially distant from other people located on the parking lot side transept. A person will no longer need to be seated by a seating ambassador and **all** rows will be available except in the designated socially distanced section, where ropes and social distance markers remain. Distribution of Holy Communion will look much closer to our pre-pandemic experience, except in the socially distanced section. The Precious Blood will remain unavailable for the foreseeable future. Communion on the tongue is permitted. Congregational singing is now allowed and we encourage your full participation. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass has been reinstated, except for those ill, infirm, unvaccinated, exposed to Covid or with another serious reason. We urge people who have gotten out of the habit of attending Mass weekly and who have no valid reason to stay away, to begin again worshipping God with fellow parishioners. ## PASTORAL VISITS

At this time during the pandemic, visits to homebound parishioners by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must be brief, and can only be done by fully vaccinated ministers whose availability may be limited. Requests for this ministry should be made through the parish office. However, if a person is dying (even in the early stages), a visit by a priest can be arranged for reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation, the Anointing of the Sick, and Viaticum (Holy Communion for the Dying) and other special prayers and blessings. These arrangements can be made by notifying a priest directly or by using the emergency option on the parish phone system.
