

ADULT FAITH FORMATION - Bible Study- A six-week course entitled "The Eucharist in Scripture" by Little Rock Scripture Study will be offered the second week of October (Tuesday mornings starting on October 11 from 9:30-11:00 am or Wednesday evenings starting on October 12 from 7-8:30 pm in the Parish Center). A registration fee of \$15 includes a study guide, reflection questions, and access to online lectures. Materials will be distributed at the first session and discussions will take place over the next five sessions. The Eucharist in Scripture explores the biblical theme of meals shared in faithful fellowship and in covenant relationship with God as we look at the concepts including sharing a meal and sacrifices in the context of the practices by early Israelites and Christians. Old Testament meals and promises provide a foundation for gospel meals with Jesus, culminating in the Last Supper as it is understood throughout the New Testament. 
