



HEALTH CARE PROXY - Very few of us think about serious illness when we are healthy. We should think ahead about what would happen if we became incapable of making our own health decisions. Stroke, dementia, unconsciousness or incompetency are just a few ways we can lose the capacity to make decisions about our treatment. Under Massachusetts law, any adult resident may authorize a person as an agent to make medical decisions in the event the ability to make these decisions is lost. A person fills out a Health Care Proxy form to name an agent. The agent can be a spouse, relative, or friend who knows the person and is trusted by him or her. The agent is empowered to make all health care decisions. Having someone legally empowered to make these decisions lessens the likelihood of family discord regarding a loved one's treatment. The Massachusetts Catholic Conference has a Health Care Proxy form consistent with Church teaching which you can download from https://macatholic.org/healthcare/. Visit the website, review the form and prayerfully consider appointing a health care agent for yourself.
