If you would like to have a loved one remembered at a parish Mass with an "announced" Mass intention, please contact our parish office at 781-934-5055 to schedule an available time. "Unannounced" Mass intentions are also available, often requested as a prayerful remembrance for someone who has died recently, for which a Mass card can be provided to bring to the wake or mailed. These Masses are celebrated when a priest is able to offer Mass for that intention, and therefore are unscheduled and without public announcement. A Mass card is available for both deceased and living intentions. Mass cards are available in the parish office during normal parish office hours. For your convenience after hours, our lower parking lot has a drop box. In the covered holder attached to the post are Mass Cards and an envelope entitled Mass Cards, which you can fill out, and leave your donation in the drop box.

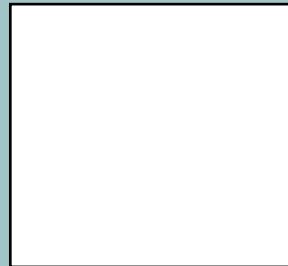
