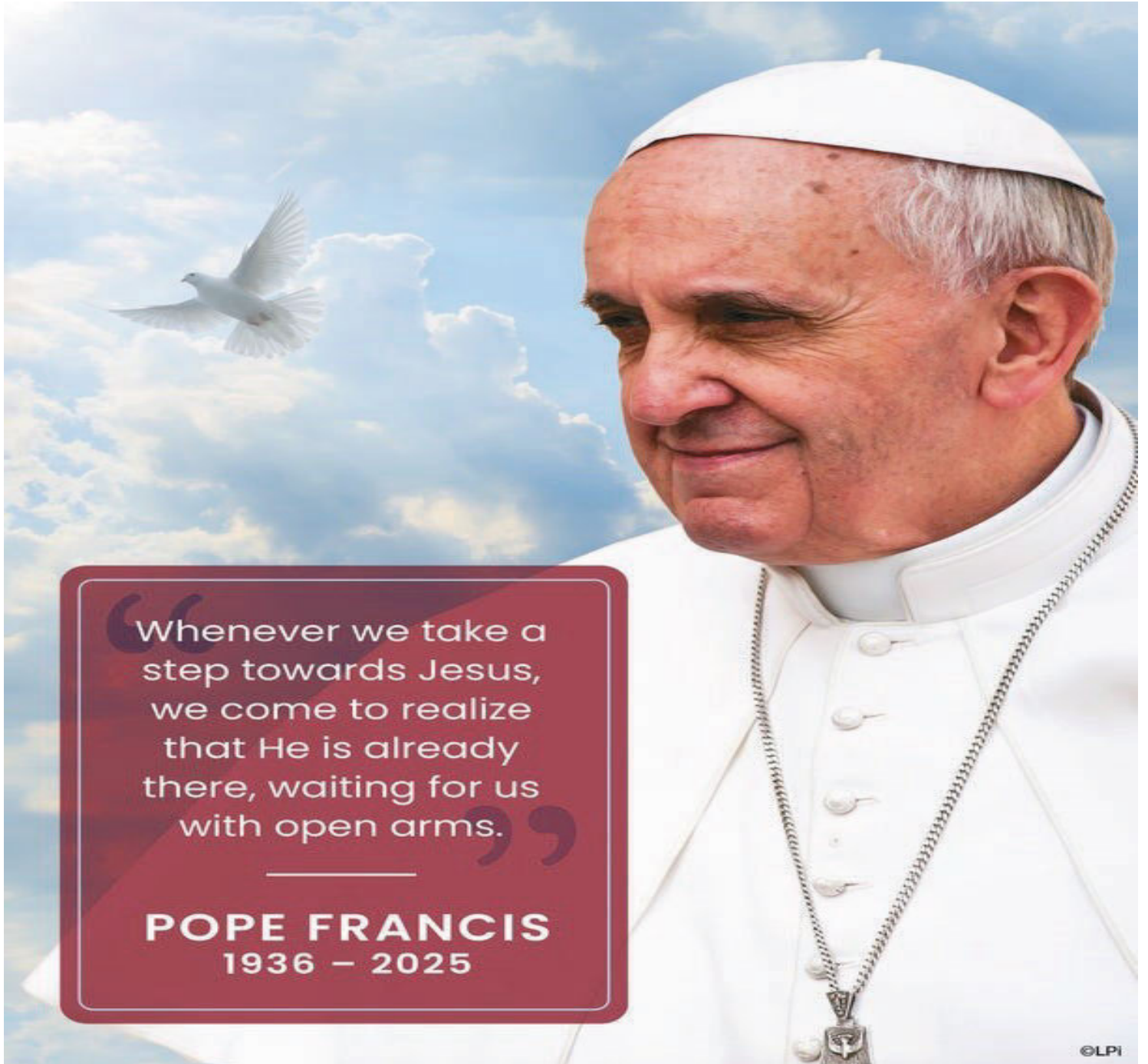

PASTOR'S CORNER

We mourn with fellow Catholics and many others throughout the world the passing of our Holy Father, Pope Francis who died on Monday, April 21. His compassion for the poor and marginalized, in imitation of the Lord Jesus, drove him to promote justice and respect for the dignity of every human being. In his last public message, known as "Urbi et Orbi," (To the City and to the World), delivered this past Easter Sunday by his master of ceremonies, Archbishop Diego Ravelli, Pope Francis challenged the leaders of our country and from around the world to care for the vulnerable and needy in their midst, and not yield to the "logic of fear." He writes, "What a great thirst for death, for killing, we witness each day in the many conflicts raging in different parts of our world! How much violence we see, often even within families, directed at women and children! How much contempt is stirred up at times towards the vulnerable, the marginalized, and migrants!... I appeal to all those in positions of political responsibility in our world not to yield to the logic of fear, which only leads to isolation from others, but rather to use the resources available to help the needy, to fight hunger and to encourage initiatives that promote development. These are the "weapons" of peace: weapons that build the future, instead of sowing seeds of death!" <https://www.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/messages/urbi/documents/20250420-urbi-et-orbi-pasqua.html>.

Pope Francis reiterated these priorities at other times during his twelve year pontificate, such as these. "Today, more than ever, our societies need 'artisans of peace' who can be messengers and authentic witnesses of God the Father, who wills the good and the happiness of the human family." "Love for the poor has been the sign, the light that draws people to give glory to the Father." Pope Francis also invited young people to view life as a pilgrimage, one marked by hope and perseverance, even through life's greatest struggles. "Dear young people, I am inviting you to set out on a journey, to discover life along the path of love, and to seek the face of God. My advice to you is this: do not set out as mere tourists, but as true pilgrims." At a time in our country when young people - and all of us - are in desperate need of honorable role models who, by word and deed, promote what is good, charitable, noble, decent and true, Pope Francis provides us with a powerful example of these virtuous qualities and a way of life that exemplifies the humility and compassion of Jesus. May Pope Francis rest in peace and pray for us!

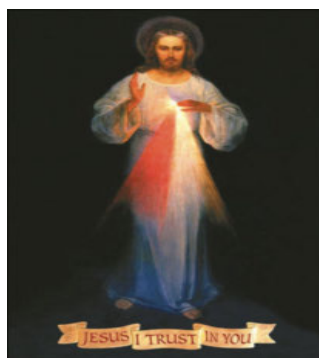

THANK YOU! - from Matt Bensman, Director of Family Faith Formation - As I think back over the last 7 years of my life, I can't help but smile, and a large part of that happiness is because of Holy Family and it's wonderful parishioners. When I first applied for the youth ministry position here, I had never been to Duxbury before and didn't know what to expect. When I pulled into the parking lot for my first interview in 2018, the parking lot was full of teens packing up probably a dozen or more 12 passenger vans and I was both intrigued and excited. They were preparing to leave the next morning for a weeklong service trip to Appalachia and I knew there was something special about this Church. I entered the parish as a stranger and am now leaving as more than a friend, but as a member of an incredible family. Thank you so much for welcoming my family into your community, it has certainly been an adventure - from all the Yee-haws at Faith Formation; the costumes at VBS and Bridge (the train conductor is still my favorite - Trust Jesus!); the Confirmation Retreats; the 4th of July Parades; the youth events and trips; transitioning from traditional faith formation to family faith formation and being able to journey with so many families as they grew closer to Jesus; helping 831 students receive the Holy Spirit at Confirmation and 248 students receiving Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion; worshiping with you all each weekend and all of the special moments over the last 7 years; the list could go on and on. We figured out life together through COVID, as we tried to stay connected to each other and the Church. You prayed and cried with our family through all of my son's health scares. You journeyed with me towards my new vocation as a deacon, as I grew in my primary vocation as a husband and a father. There has been enough joy filled, God moments from the last 7 years to fill an entire lifetime. There are too many people to thank individually, but I hope you all know how appreciative I am for each and every one of you. I hope you might be able to join me at Holy Cross Cathedral in Boston on September 13th for my Ordination as a permanent Deacon, and I am excited that Fr. Bob has invited me back to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving at Holy Family in September. So, today (Farewell Reception after today's 10:30 am Mass) is certainly not a goodbye, but rather, it is an until we see each other again. 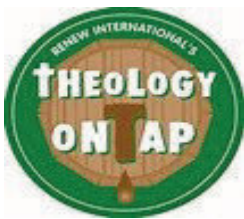

This Thursday, May 1. Oscar Delgado will speak promptly at 6:30 pm New World Tavern 56 Main Street, Plymouth. Human Trafficking Commercial Exploitation of God's Children; Vulnerable People Groups past and present. Oscar Delgado leads a survivors' network and multiple anti-trafficking education programs. Delgado was the co-director of a National Anti-Trafficking Prevention Program in Mexico. He is also responsible for helping to create the award-winning multilingual AWAKE Anti-Trafficking Virtual Reality Program that was used in the Brazil Olympics and both Houston and Minneapolis Super Bowls. A native of Mexico City, Oscar was vaguely aware of trafficking and never thought it happened in his city. The turning point for Oscar came when someone prayed, he would be able to see and care for the things God sees and cares for. Soon after, he became acutely aware of how pervasive human trafficking was in his own backyard. "Once I started to open my eyes ... I felt like I had to do something," he said. 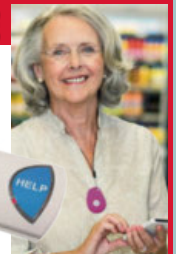
