



Well, he won't be available to help us out much longer because Pope Leo XIV appointed him the Bishop of the Diocese of Albany, New York last Monday. He will be installed on December 5, 2025. Those who know him knew it was just a matter of time when he would be asked to lead a

diocese. A very approachable person, Bishop Mark has many gifts, extensive experience in various roles of Church leadership, and offers a very pastoral approach to all that he does. After his ordination to the episcopacy in 2016, Bishop Mark served as the Regional Bishop of the North Region of the archdiocese as well as Pastor of St. Theresa Parish in North Reading. In 2023, he was appointed Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia of the Archdiocese by Cardinal Sean O'Malley. statement released following the announcement, Archbishop Richard Henning said, "I have had the blessing over the last year to work with Bishop Mark O'Connell. He is a remarkably capable man and very humble. He loves people and he loves the priests of our archdiocese. He has served Boston joyfully and effectively for decades. I am truly honored to be your bishop and embrace this role with great joy. Wherever this journey leads, I will walk with you, guided by the hope and peace of the Risen Lord. I ask for your prayers and goodwill, and I pledge the same to you." 
