CHALK YOUR DOOR AT EPIPHANY

What: A traditional Epiphany blessing asking God's protection and presence in our homes for the year ahead. The chalk marking includes the year and C + M + B, honoring the Magi and meaning "Christ bless this home."

How: Use blessed chalk to mark the inscription above your front door and say a simple prayer together.

When: Anytime on or around Epiphany (January 6).

Blessed chalk available: The chalk will be blessed at the 9:00 am Mass today, January 4 and at Bridge this weekend and will be available in Narthex until January 6.

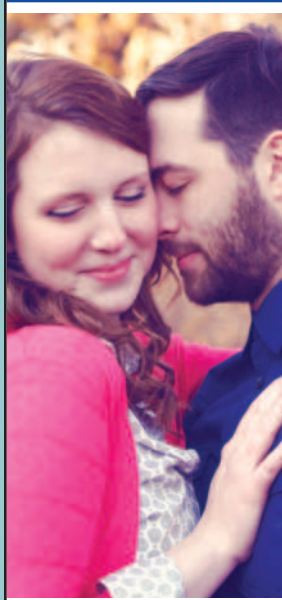
