You may have noticed that we have recently installed a stained glass window (shown above) in our newly renovated Msgr. Glynn Parish Center. It was in storage in our attic for many years, and it seemed fitting to have this beautiful image of the Holy Family refurbished and backlit to enhance this space. It's one of many decorative additions planned to complete the renovation. The scene depicted in this stained glass window is of the "Flight into Egypt." The story is taken from the Gospel account in Matthew 2 describing Joseph and Mary's effort to protect Jesus from being killed by King Herod's massacre of infants by fleeing to Egypt.

This circumstance brings to mind modern day refugees, some of whom have sought Temporary Protected Status (TPS) here in the U.S. because of serious threats to their own and their family's life. Jesus, Mary and Joseph were not immune to such threats in their own day, and depended upon the goodness and hospitality of "neighbors" to help them in their time of need. May this scene prompt us to pray, not only for the wellbeing of modern day refugees who seek such care and outreach, but also for a cultivation of compassion, openness and generosity within societies that are in a position to be of assistance... like our own.

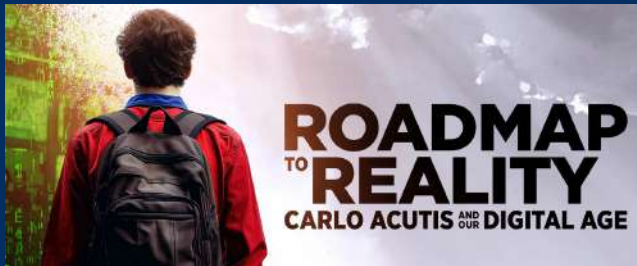

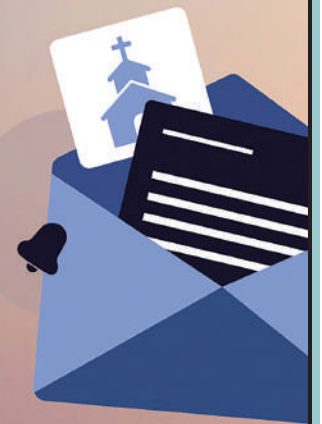
