A Note from Fr. Bob

Do you long to be more centered, focused and recollected amidst the hectic, often whirlwind pace we keep?

Summer affords us some free time to try a new way to achieve these goals. The way we go about this effort is vital to achieving fruitfulness. Our rich Catholic spiritual tradition provides one particular way that far surpasses merely taking a breath, slowing down or practicing centering techniques because it allows God to be our source of centeredness, where His life-giving Spirit provides refreshment, peace and inspiration. It touches upon a supernatural reality. Boston College philosophy professor, Peter Kreeft, in his book, *Jesus-Shock* describes silence in Eucharistic Adoration as having “a power greater than a thousand nuclear bombs... for it is Christ... We touch the candle of our souls to the fire of His passion for souls, and we catch that flame ... But we must do this for His sake, not for our sakes... He is not a means to any end; He is the end.” Eucharistic Adoration is available in our chapel daily (accessible at the rear of the church) from 9 am to 4 pm, and on Fridays we have Exposition of the Eucharistic Jesus displayed in the monstrance from 9 am to 9 pm. This summer, let the silent transformative connection with the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration make a profound difference in your life.

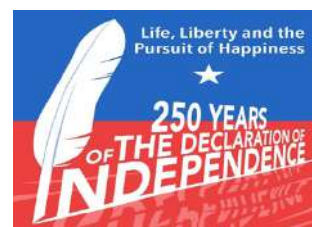
