Important Updates for This Year's Program

Getting Started - All families in first or second grade begin by **scheduling a meeting with Jen or Jeanne**. This informal conversation is the first step for both new and returning families.

FIRST GRADE



New This Year: First Communion preparation now begins in **Grade 1** with **Seek**, the foundation of our Pathways program. Families can choose from several session options, each meeting just **4 times**.

FIRST COMMUNION



Second Grade: Incoming second graders do not **need** to complete the Seek program. However, **all families are required to schedule a meeting with Jen or Jeanne** before beginning First Communion preparation.

Bridge Family Faith Formation



For returning families with children in PreK–Grade 7, BRIDGE helps parents and children grow together through shared faith formation and family-centered learning.

Anointing of the Sick: Frequently Asked Questions

When should a priest be called?

Please don't wait until the last moments of life. Calling while your loved one is still conscious allows them to participate in the prayers and, if they wish, receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion. It also gives family members the opportunity to gather and pray together.

Isn't this the "Last Rites"?

No. While the Anointing of the Sick was once closely associated with those near death, the Church teaches that this sacrament is for anyone facing serious illness, surgery, or the challenges of advanced age. It offers God's grace, strength, peace, and healing.

Can someone receive the Anointing of the Sick more than once?

Yes. A person may be anointed again if they recover and later become seriously ill, or if their condition worsens during the same illness.

If you or a loved one is facing serious illness, preparing for surgery, or experiencing the challenge of aging, please speak with a priest after Mass or call the parish office to schedule.
